

Basketball as a Mission
Code of Conduct for Camps

Basketball as a Mission strives to enrich the lives of underprivileged children by igniting a passion for basketball and merging cultures through the love of the game. Coaches are expected to behave in a particular manner, and by signing this Code of Conduct, agree to the following standards of behavior:

- I. There will be no inappropriate behavior or relationships with any camper at any time.
- II. All coaches MUST remain with the group (or in a smaller group, no less than three) at all times.
- III. There will be absolutely no smoking, drinking, or substances used during any trip with Basketball as a Mission ever.
- IV. Coaches must treat one another with respect, and must respect the practices of the organization, including reflection and prayer. Coaches will also be expected to lead at least one prayer before a meal.
- V. Coaches will not teach campers inappropriate behaviors, only positive behavior.
- VI. There will be photos of camp and the trips taken, coaches agree to having their photos on our website and other internet links, as well as sharing their photos with the organization for use on the website and other links.
- VII. Coaches will be open to trying and learning new things, willing to give of themselves in order to get the full Basketball as a Mission experience.
